Internet Global Outreach Growing and Getting Stronger

Church websites sees Russian Federation hits increase to more than 67 per day

Harrisburg, PA – For the second consecutive month, the Russian Federation emerged as the top country that is accessing the Urban Life Church website.

“Get ready brother,” Pastor Mark Lawrence of the Kingdom First Ministries International (Chesapeake, Virginia) said to senior Pastor Christopher Green, “We may have to form a team and go into that nation someday.”

It’s a possibility that this local urban community pastor does not take lightly. Missions and outreach have always been a part of his life. Back in the 1960’s, almost every year, James and Jane Green took their children to see and hear several missionaries from Africa or Asia.

“At the time we didn’t realize how innovative and brave our parents were,” recalls Pastor Chris. “We were typical inner city kids, but our parents always did things to expose us to more than life in the ghetto. My dad would take us on long drives into the suburbs to see the nicer homes and neighborhoods. My mom would buy books and leave them out for us to read. We explored the world through the old Britannica Encyclopedia collections.”

But his parents didn’t stop there. They would drive their family to St. Louis’ predominant white south side of the city to the Tower Grove Baptist Church. This congregation sponsored and supported several missionary teams all over the world. When they held their annual banquet to raise funds for missions, they allowed several missionaries to share their stories and reports. The Green family, often the only Black family in the audience, was sitting right there absorbing the fire and passion for souls.

“I don’t think my parents realized the impact that was being made on their kids,” adds this founder of a ministry that aggressively reaches out to people who know very little or nothing about the church. “To this day, we still don’t follow the conventional direction of most inner city ministries. Our strategy in Harrisburg’s urban community is the same strategy we learned while listening to those missionaries. We didn’t come into this community to take anything from anyone. We didn’t come into this community to make the people financially support us. Just like those missionaries that I grew up listening to, we came into the community to SERVE and GIVE.”

That’s why the Urban Life Church provides a free breakfast every Sunday morning, along with free books, music CD’s and DVD’s to all who attend. They offer free classes and sessions to help people navigate through life in areas ranging from marriage to life management.

“We are missionaries in the urban community,” explains Pastor Chris. “We look to the Lord to send us the financial support so that we can continue to reach out to this community, and now, (via internet) around the world.”

Urban Life Church, which is supported by its few members and by many more people all over the United States, first noticed the global outreach increasing in March. They realized that it was not a fluke when it increased in April. Suddenly it has begun to explode as seen in its May 2010 analytics report.



























“I’m just a ghetto kid that God touched at four years old,” concludes this urban and internet pastor. “I never dreamed that I would someday be a missionary within my own nation, reaching out to the world through technology. Something special is happening and we just want to be faithful to do our part. When we pass the baton on to our sons and their children, who knows what God can do if they have a solid foundation from which to grow and go global with the good news.”
